

Diversity model: a new bioethics versión from the perspective of persons with functional diversity (disability)

Abstract:

In the early XXI century, in Spain and the major part of the world, reality, so in the common day as in juridical and bioethics productions is discriminatory for persons with functional diversity. Although the evolution of the social approach theoretical models, initiated from disregard toward an evolution to a rehabilitation model, which, at the same time, brought to the current social model, social politics based on these models continue being ineffective providing answers for the definitive eradication of this group of persons discrimination. A new model is proposed in which disability theoretical axis is replaced by dignity theoretical axis: the diversity model.
